

Short report for Classis Central (Contracta) Rockingham

On 4th December, 2025, on behalf of the FRC Rockingham, Rev. Anderson opened the meeting in a Christian manner. Delegates were present from FRCs Rockingham, Cardup Brook, and Darling Downs. All delegates rose to express their agreement to the Three Forms of Unity. The following officers were appointed: Rev. D. Poppe as chairman, Rev. R den Boer as vice-chairman, br. Fred Ballast as clerk. The following documents were presented to classis in relation to the letter of call from Rockingham to call Rev. Anderson for the special task of pre-seminary language training: material for the budget, documents to show that the church of Rockingham supported the proposal, information about the oversight committee, and the final letter of call. It was noted that FRC Rockingham appreciates the strong support they received from the churches for the proposal. Funding from the churches will be required when Rockingham receives a new Minister of the Word. Classis approved the documents and signed the letter of call. Rev. Anderson reflected with thankfulness on his time in Rockingham, and is excited for this new task, after 29 years in pastoral ministry. The acts were adopted and press release approved, and the vice-chairman closed in prayer.
